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Why ADIT?

In order to stand out from the crowd, today's tax professional must ideally have a varied background, a solid understanding of more than one taxation system, and the ability to offer a range of service to clients.

The ADIT is a challenging yet rewarding qualification that will help you identify as a true international tax specialist. It is perfect for senior level tax professionals and managers, or people working towards a senior level in international tax, who are looking to develop their knowledge and further their career, with no prerequisites needed.

Designed by a board of world-leading experts, ADIT is an International, Advanced Level Specialist Qualification, offered by The Chartered Institute of Taxation (CIOT, UK).

To obtain this certification, students must complete 3 modules:

- Paper 1 - Principles of International Taxation (compulsory module)
- Any 2 of the available option modules:
 - Paper 2 - Jurisdiction
 - Paper 3 - Thematic.

The modules can be completed in any order and all exams can be taken in the same session.

Students can also opt to complete an extended thesis (15,000-20,000 words) on an International Tax subject of their choice, in lieu of one of the option modules.

- The ADIT is a **flexible qualification**, which means you can adapt your study options according to your work commitments and available resources.

Certificates of attendance will be awarded to eligible participants wishing to validate their Continuous Professional Development (CPDs).

Terms of Enrolment & Payment

The ADIT course is generally expected to commence at the end of February.

Candidates are asked to kindly complete the online form and indicate the module for which they wish to register before the closing date for registration, which will be communicated to you at the time. Two days after the closing date for registration, the administrators will contact candidates to inform them whether the module for which they registered will be offered. Should the desired module not be available, candidates will be offered suitable alternatives from which to choose.

To be eligible to attend the Globaltraining ADIT courses and granted access to the Moodle Platform, students must complete the enrolment form and ensure that fees from previous term(s) are fully settled. Should you have any questions or need assistance, our administration team is available to support and guide you.

Due to the flexible nature of online courses, some students may join a course late. These students will be allowed access to the LoL sessions through the Globaltraining Moodle Platform.

Students dropping a course after its commencement will be charged a fee based on a pro-rata basis. The course drop is valid as of the date that Globaltraining is notified via the Drop form submitted to our department. Students cannot drop a paper eight weeks before the mock exam.

Candidates whose fees are partly or fully covered by their employers should submit upon enrolment their sponsorship letter.

Fees and Discount Schemes

Each module provided leading to the ADIT qualification is priced at €1,300.

Tuition fees include the cost of study material and mock exams, as well as the teaching sessions provided by each lecturer as per their own individual teaching style.

Tuition fees do not include any amounts payable towards the Chartered Institute of Taxation (student registration and examination fees).

Should a participant wish to only register for the revision phase, they will be responsible for obtaining materials themselves, as these are not included in the revision fees.

Participants who settle fully their fees by 30th September 2022 will be offered a 10% discount.

Participants who attend all ADIT papers with Globaltraining will also be eligible for a discount of 10% on their last paper fees.

ADIT Student Registration & Exam Deadlines / Fees

ADIT Student Registration:

In order to sit an ADIT exam, a candidate must first register to become an ADIT student.

The registration process is very simple and can be done via the online application:

- **ADIT student registration deadline is on the 2nd of September 2022.**

ADIT exam registration deadlines:

Once registered in the ADIT program, a student can register to sit for an exam,

- **Entry for the December sitting 16th September 2022.**

Remote Exams:

All ADIT exams in December 2022 will be sat remotely. This means you will be taking the exam in the comfort of your chosen location.
