



Fund Administration and Reporting Obligations to CySEC

Aim:

The new AIF Law in 2018, as well as numerous circulars from CySEC, have altogether increased both the workload and the quality of compliance and reporting obligations for both the funds and their service providers. Hence, fund administration, is attracting more and more attention, not just from compliance and regulatory perspective, but also in relation to its actual content. This seminar will emphasize primarily on giving a practical, inner sight of the role and the range of services of a fund administrator. The main aim is to familiarize the participants with the duties and tasks of a fund administrator and how this might take the form of a regulated profession.
