ICAEW CFAB IS OF PARTICULAR VALUE TO ASPIRING ACA CANDIDATES WHO WISH TO GAIN A MORE COMPETITIVE EDGE AS THEY APPLY FOR TRAINING CONTRACT WITH ICAEW AUTHORISED TRAINING EMPLOYERS. IT IS ALSO CONSIDERED A ROUTE FOR THE ACA QUALIFICATION, AS IT COVERS THE FIRST SIX MODULES (CERTIFICATE LEVEL).

THERE ARE NO MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS TO DO THE ICAEW CFAB QUALIFICATION AND IS OPEN TO ALL; SCHOOL LEAVERS, GRADUATES, AND EMPLOYEES WORKING IN BUSINESS AND FINANCE OR PROFESSIONALS CONSIDERING A CAREER CHANGE. ICAEW CFAB IS A VERY FLEXIBLE PROGRAM AND GLOBALTRAINING PROVIDES COURSES ONLINE AND IN-CLASS. CANDIDATES CAN REGISTER AND TAKE THE COMPUTER BASED EXAMS AT ICAEW APPROVED TEST CENTERS UPON THEIR DEMAND, AT ANY TIME OF YEAR.
